**TODAY'S MASS THEME**  
**THOUGHT**

The gospel of today is from the last part of Chapter 18 which, as we have seen already last Sunday, deals with the problems in the life of Mathew's communities. Today it has emphasized forgiveness. How should Christians behave with those who offend them? Can they retaliate? Not even once?

Both the gospel passage and the first reading reply clearly that the only possible human and Christian attitude is forgiveness.

The second reading is connected to this because it recommends understanding toward those who within the community hold opinions which are different from ours.
