FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME 2022

Parents who wish to enrol their child (children) into First Holy Communion Programme for 2022, please, pick up the application form at the back of the church and return the form as soon as possible. Your child must be 8 years of age on or before 31st December 2021. Completed form should be returned on or before 12 September 2021. Once the form is sent back, you will be issued with a pre-First Holy Communion Passport. This Passport must be signed every Sunday to indicate that your child has been to Mass. The programme will start with parents' meeting early December 2021, and it is essential that parents attend.
